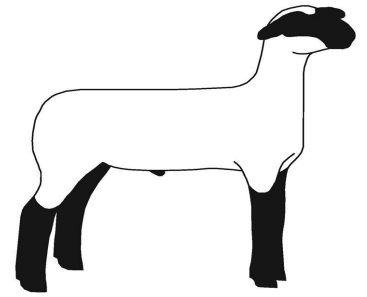


# Department P

## JUNIOR MARKET LAMB SHOW (Rules and Regulations)

*Sheep will be accepted only from Alexander, Burke, Caldwell, Catawba, Cleveland, Gaston, Iredell, Lincoln, McDowell & Rutherford Counties Only  
Or active members of the Catawba Valley Youth Showmanship Circuit*



- (1) Junior Market Lamb Show will be held on Monday, September 4<sup>th</sup> immediately after the Junior Market Lamb Showmanship. Entries must be in place by 10:30 AM.
- (2) Exhibitors must be 21 years of age or under as of January 1, 2023.
- (3) Exhibitors must be residents of counties listed or an active member of the Catawba Valley Youth Showmanship circuit.
- (4) Lambs must be owned by the exhibitors at least 30 days before show date.
- (5) Lambs shown must be wethers or ewes (NO RAMS).
- (6) Lambs may be shown at halter. Major fitting should be done prior to arrival at Fair.
- (7) Lambs will be shown as individuals. Each exhibitor is limited to two entries.
- (8) If a junior has more than one lamb in a class, the other lamb must be shown by a junior approved by the Show Superintendent.
- (9) Class size will be determined after weigh in and classes will be broken by weight at the discretion of the Show Superintendent.

## JUNIOR MARKET LAMB SHOWMANSHIP CONTEST

### Entries and Awards

- (1) The Junior Showmanship Contest is open to all junior exhibitors who participate in the **Junior Market Lamb Show**.
- (2) Those exhibitors under 9 years of age MAY enter the Novice/Participation class if they desire. These exhibitors will not be placed and will all receive the same premium.
- (3) Basis for awards will be 25% fitting and 75% showmanship.
- (4) To be immediately after Junior Market Goat Show

## OPEN SHEEP SHOW

**Judging Starts:** Monday, September 4th, 2023,  
after the Market Lamb Show.

**Entries Close:** Wednesday, August 23, 2023.

**Show Order:** Hampshire, All Other Breeds, Commercial, Suffolk. (Commercial animals will be shown by weight)

**Competition:** Open to any resident of counties listed or an active member of the Catawba Valley Showmanship Circuit

**Health:** See details at beginning of Department "P".

- (1) ALL SHEEP MUST BE CLEAN AND PROPERLY FITTED TO QUALIFY FOR ENTRY IN THIS SHOW.
- (2) All animals (in Purebred classes) over three months of age must be registered with their breed association in the name of the bona fide owner, who must have owned the animal for at least 30 days before show date.
- (3) Each exhibitor is limited to two entries per class.
- (4) Superintendent reserves the right to limit entries according to barn space. Make your entries early.

Exhibitors may use any ideas they wish on how to "dress" or "decorate" their sheep to represent any personality, place or thing. Costumes may consist of any material as long as it is not considered harmful to the animal or potentially harmful to other exhibitors. Presence in the show ring constitutes entry in the class. Judging will be based on creativity and attractiveness.
