OPEN BEEF CATTLE SHOW

Information for Open Show Beef Cattle Exhibitors:

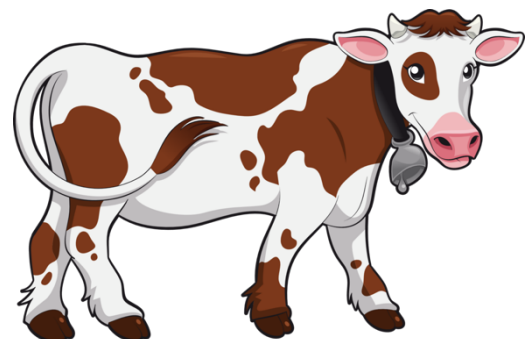
- (1) **Competition:** Open to any exhibitor in Caldwell, Catawba, Burke, Alexander, Cleveland, Lincoln, Iredell and Gaston Counties only, or an active member of the Catawba Valley Youth Showmanship Circuit. Any animal entered in both the Open & Jr. Shows must be entered under the name of the same exhibitor in both shows.
- (2) **Cost per Head:** \$5.00 Send with Entry Form.
- (3) **Entries Close:** Wednesday, August 24th, 2022. **NO FAXED ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED. ENTER BY MAIL ONLY.**
- (4) **Health:** Livestock may be inspected prior to unloading.
- (5) **Cattle Receiving Times:** All day Thursday until dusk, or Friday 7:00AM til 2:00 PM or Saturday from 7:00am to 11:00am. Stall assignments will be made in the order entries received. Entries will be capped when the barn is full and late entries will be returned. The Barn Superintendent reserves the right to limit entries.
- (6) **Cattle Must Be in Place By:** 3:00 PM, Friday or Noon on Saturday.
- (7) **Judging Starts:** Friday at 5:00pm and 3:00pm on Saturday.
- (8) **Show Order:**(1) Commercial, (2) Hereford, (3) Shorthorn, (4) Simmental, (5) Angus, (6) AOB (7) Charolais
- (9) **Release of Exhibits:** Barn Superintendent will grant release time. **PREMIUMS WILL BE FORFEITED IF ANIMALS ARE REMOVED PRIOR TO PERMISSION FROM BARN SUPERINTENDENT OR NO INSPECTION AFTER REMOVAL.**

NOTE: A few selected Open Show Beef Cattle entries MAY be asked to remain in the barn for the entire week for exhibition purposes. However, the need for this may not arise, depending on barn space.

NOTE: Exhibitors must have the original registration certificate on each animal available for inspection at the show.

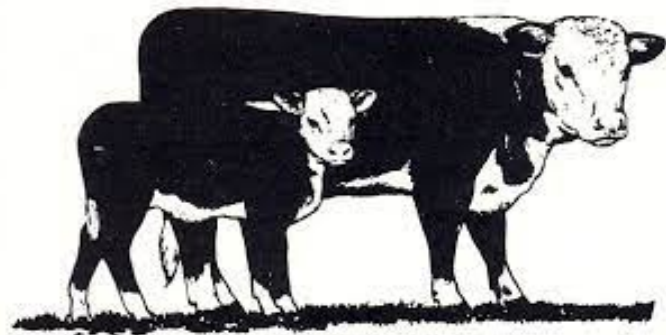

JUNIOR BEEF HEIFER SHOW

(Rules and Regulations)

- (1) Junior Beef Heifer Show will be on Saturday, September 2, 2023. All animals exhibited in the Junior Beef Heifer Show must be entered under the same exhibitor for the Open Beef Cattle Show.
- (2) Open to exhibitors 21 years of age and under as of January 1, 2023, all of whom must be residents of counties listed or active members of the Catawba Valley Youth Showmanship circuit.
- (3) Heifers must have been born on or after September 1, 2021, but no later than February 28, 2023.
- (4) Exhibitors must have trained and fitted the animal from June 15, 2022. Ownership by exhibitors is not required; however, in cases where exhibitors do not own the animal, a certificate of training and fitting from the owner is required at entry time.
- (5) If an exhibitor has more than one entry per class, the additional animal must be shown by another junior approved by the Superintendent.
- (6) Each exhibitor is limited to two entries per class.
- (7) Heifers must be halter broken. Unruly animals that may endanger the safety of exhibitors may be asked to leave the ring.
- (8) **HEALTH** – No Health Certificate required – Livestock may be inspected prior to unloading.

JUNIOR MARKET STEER SHOW

(Rules and Regulations)

- (1) Junior Market Steer Show will be held on Saturday, September 2, 2023.
- (2) Exhibitors must be 21 years of age or under as of show date and residents of counties listed in the Cattle Department or members of the Catawba Valley Youth Showmanship Circuit.
- (3) If a junior has more than one steer in a class, the other steer must be shown by a junior approved by the Show Superintendent.
- (4) Each exhibitor is limited to two entries.
- (5) Steers must be halter broken and dehorned. Unruly animals that may endanger the safety of exhibitors may be asked to leave the ring.
- (6) Class size will be determined after weigh in and classes may be broken; by eight at the discretion of the Superintendent.
- (7) Any questions not covered by these rules will be ruled on by the Show Superintendent.

JUNIOR FEEDER CALF SHOW

(Rules and regulations)

- (1) The Feeder Calf Show will be held on Saturday afternoon following Showmanship, September 2, 2023.
- (2) Each exhibitor is limited to two (2) entries.
- (3) Calves must be halter broken and dehorned. Unruly animals that may endanger the safety of exhibitors may be asked to leave the ring.
- (4) Class size will be limited to 6 head. If the number exceeds 6, the entries will be divided to form additional classes at the discretion of the Show Superintendent.
- (5) Any questions not covered by these rules will be ruled by the Show Superintendent.
- (6) Calves must be completely healed from castration. Clamped calves will not be allowed.

Costume Class for Junior Beef and Steer Cross Project

Costumes may consist of any material as long as it is not considered harmful to the animal or potentially harmful to other exhibitors. Presence in the show ring constitutes entry in the class. Judging will be based on creativity and attractiveness.

- (9) Calves must be halter broken and dehorned. Unruly animals that may endanger the safety of exhibitors may be asked to leave the ring.
- (10) Class size will be limited to 6 head. Classes will be divided by weight and breed. If the number exceeds 6, the entries will be divided to form additional classes at the discretion of the Show Superintendent.
- (11) Any questions not covered by these rules will be ruled by the Show Superintendent.
- (12) Calves must be completely healed from castration. Clamped calves will not be allowed.
